Staff Spotlight: Adrienne Acuña Skowron

What's Happening

With a bipartisan vote of 94-1, the US Senate passed legislation for the COVID-19 Hate Crimes Act. This legislation will expedite the Justice Department's review of hate crimes, as the Asian American community has seen an increase in incidents during the coronavirus pandemic. It will also task the department with coordinating with local law enforcement groups and community-based organizations to facilitate and raise awareness about hate-crime reporting.

A minority demographic (whether based on ethnicity, race, or religion) whose members are perceived to achieve a higher degree of socioeconomic success than the population average, thus portrayed as a "model" for other groups to emulate.
