Let's Recognize

- Juneteenth, also called Freedom Day, celebrates the emancipation of enslaved Black Americans in the United States. Originating in Galveston, Texas, it is celebrated on June 19 throughout the United States. Juneteenth commemorates the anniversary date of June 19, 1865, and announcement of General Order No. 3, declaring freedom from slavery in Texas, one of the last remaining U.S. states that had slavery. It's regarded and celebrated as the end of slavery in the US.
- Caribbean-American Heritage Month was adopted by the U.S. House of Representatives in 2005 to recognize and honor the achievements, contributions and significance of Caribbean people and their descendants in the history and culture of the United States.
- The Stonewall Riots are the historic uprising by the Greenwich Village LGBTQIA+ community, in response to years of harassment by authorities. On June 28, 1969, NYC police raided the gay bar The Stonewall Inn, where tensions quickly escalated, as patrons resisted arrest. The encounter erupted in riots that went on for three days. The Stonewall Riots are considered the catalyst and one of the most important events leading to the fight for establishment and protection of LGBTQIA+ rights in the United States. In 2016, the area around the Stonewall Inn, still a popular nightspot today, was designated a national monument.
- June is African American Music Appreciation Month. Created by President Jimmy Carter in 1979, and originally called Black Music Month, it celebrates the African American musical influences that comprise an essential part of the United States treasured cultural heritage.

What's Happening

- June marks the 51st celebration of Pride Month, when millions of people come together in support of the LGBTQIA+ community. The nation's first Gay Pride marches were held a year after the Stonewall Riots, widely viewed as the catalyst for the gay liberation movement.
- Last month, a group of Democratic lawmakers sent a letter asking President Joe Biden to mandate the "X" marker, as a gender option on passports. Currently, 20 US states and Washington, D.C., offer driver's licenses with an "X" marker in the gender/sex field in addition to the traditional "F" or "M," and some offer nonbinary birth certificates as well.

Nonbinary • adjective
An umbrella term in gender identity, increasingly used by people who identify as somewhere along the spectrum of gender, either between male and female or outside the traditional binary altogether.

LGBTQIA+ • acronym
Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer or Questioning, Intersex, Asexual, Other
Non-Heterosexual. The "+" is used to be inclusive and represent a number of different gender identities and sexual orientations that are not already present in the lettered acronym.
